

Paradise Street, Birmingham



The Paradise Street Offices were purchased by the Company in 1886 and served as the Birmingham HQ until 1932. The building was still in existence in 1959 and is recorded in one of Alton Douglas's books "Birmingham, A Look Back" It was swept away shortly afterwards however to make way for Birmingham's Inner Ring Road. The 2010 photograph above is of Suffolk Street Queensway and the scaffolded building is on the corner of Paradise Street. The old building was probably just in front of this, underneath the route of Queensway.
