

Wednesbury Reservoir, Church Hill, Wednesbury







The reservoir was originally constructed in 1860 as an uncovered receptacle. A roof was added in 1923. Following abandonment in 1974 the site was sold and is now occupied by a private residence. Whilst no trace of the former reservoir remains it is interesting to speculate whether the municipal style steel fencing sections inset into the ornamental wall pillars in the modern photograph were rescued from the demolition spoil. The street plan on the far left dates from 1921 and shows the exact location of the reservoir and this has been transposed on to the modern street layout.
