
Surge Stack, Brownhills





In the plans drawn up in 1853 for parliamentary approval, a summit reservoir at the highest point on the water main between Lichfield and Walsall was proposed. This was never built, however a surge stack was constructed instead. It was demolished, probably in the early 1970's, when the railway main was abandoned. No trace remains in 2010.
