

Seedy Mill Borehole and Blithe Pumping Stations, Hanch, Nr. Lichfield



The borehole station was completed in 1939 and provided one and a half million gallons of water per day to Gentleshaw Reservoir near Cannock. Today the source has been branded "Elmhurst Spring" and supplies water to a bottling plant on the same site.



The Seedy Mill Blithe Works were completed in four phases between 1943 and 1956 and were capable of supplying fifteen million gallons of water to reservoirs at Cannock, Burton on Trent and Barr Beacon.
